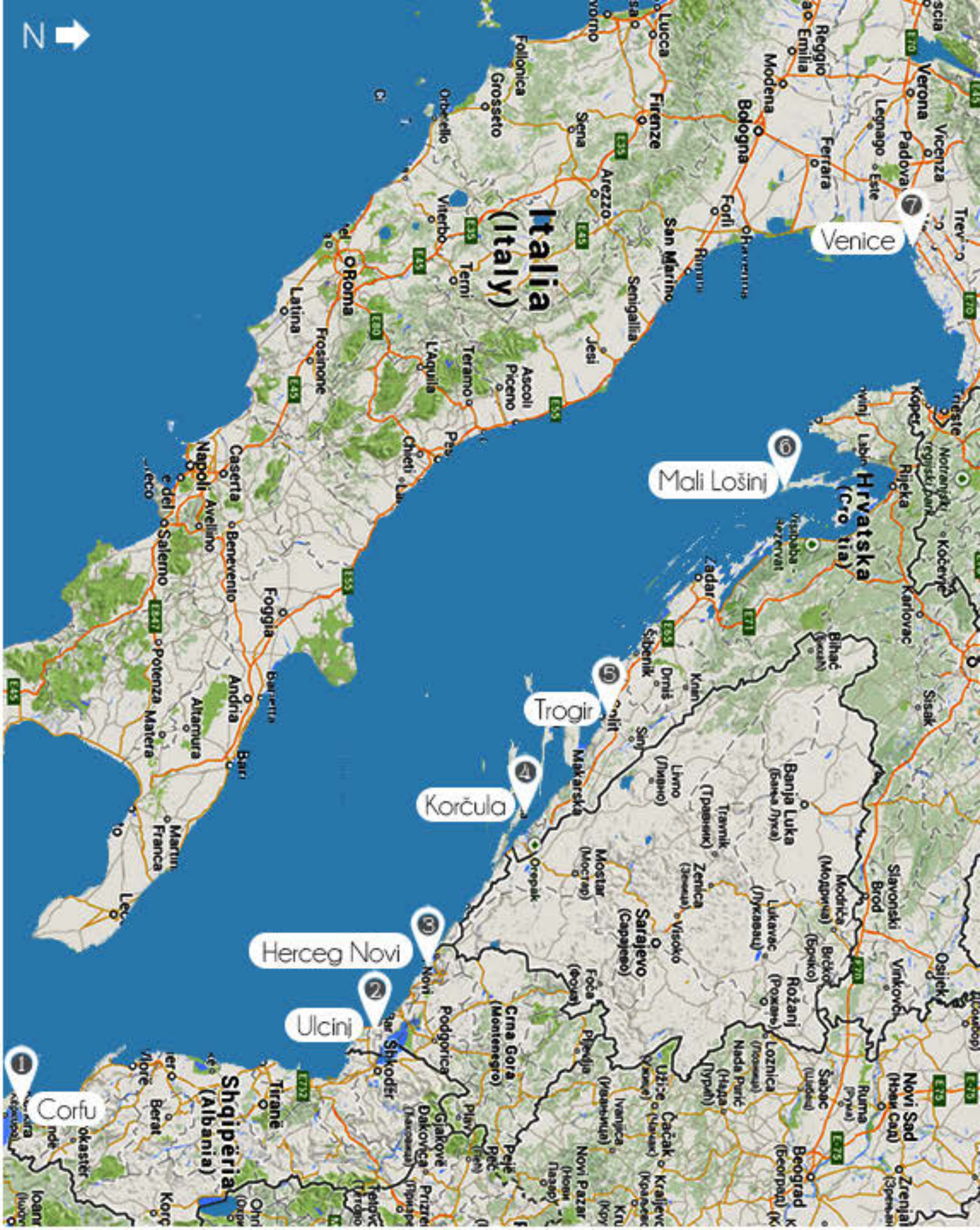

# CORFU

The Greenest Island

Commence your unforgettable journey through the Adriatic Sea in Corfu, a green island dangling bellow the heel of Italy. Corfu's interior oozes with hazy olive groves, stately cypresses and rugged mountains while its coastline is punctuated with eye-catching beaches. With rich intellectual and artistic roots, Corfu's legacy is visible through its fine museums and its high-merit, Italian-influenced cuisine.





Spend the day wondering the streets of Venetian Corfu Town, then survey Albania from the rocky pinnacle of Pantokrator before plunging in to the Adriatic Sea for your first of many afternoon swims.





# ULCINJ

An Eastern Feel

Boasting an Oriental feel with its elegant minarets towering above numerous mosques, Ulcinj is home to the longest beach of the Adriatic sea. The Velika plaza offers indeed 13 km (8 miles) of beach made out of the pettiest grains of grayish and warm sand. Situated at the southernmost point of the Montenegrin coast, Ulcinj is a charming historical beach town like no other.

Admire the Old City's "fortress of unique beauty", which encircles the town with big stonewalls that have been the keepers of its history, culture and tradition for several centuries. Then hop back aboard STARFIRE for an elegant dinner at sea.







Easily recognisable for its abundance of mimosa trees and its numerous flights of stairs, Herceg Novi hides an interesting Stari Grad (Old Town) with sunny squares and an energetic atmosphere. Covering six centuries, the city's many palaces, churches, historical monuments and cultural edifices testify to the town's tumultuous past.

# KORČULA

A Medieval Cocoon



Korčula's charm is unprecedented with its fortification that seem to hang off the seas like the bastions of an overgrown sandcastle. Offering a gorgeous grid of marble streets that gives way to magnificent architecture, Korčula Town could very well be a smaller version of Dubrovnik. The city boasts the same high walls and circular corner fortresses and a comparable protruding 15th-century Revelin tower that hovers over an expanse of red shimmering roofs.





Drink some of Korčula's excellent white wine in a quaint local bistro as you wrap your senses around how life was lived centuries ago. Imagine Marco Polo running around this labyrinth of streets before setting sail on his historical adventures



# TROGIR

An Enchanting  
Town

Showing a picture-perfect profile, remarkably well-preserved stonewalls and a medieval character, it is no wonder that UNESCO added the entire town of Trogir to its World Heritage List back in 1997.

Reminiscent of a medieval tale, Trogir's walls are embellished by countless coat of arms over its doorways and windows showing a glimpse into its chaotic past.

Admire the startling architectural difference between imposing Romanesque churches and the many Renaissance and Baroque buildings hinting at Trogir's Venetian era. Then dance the night away, enjoying the charming air of this unique Croatian city.
